This order replaces the version of the 20^{th} Judicial District Administrative Order 22-104 dated May 22, 2023.

This 20th Judicial District Administrative Order 22-104 is intended to provide authority to perform certain duties in traffic infraction cases to the Clerk of Court, or their designees, within the Twentieth Judicial District.

Pursuant to C.R.S. §13-6-212(2)(f), the Chief Judge of a judicial district, upon approval of the Chief Justice of the Supreme Court may authorize the clerk of the county court, with the consent of the defendant, to accept pleas of guilty and admissions of liability and impose penalties pursuant to an approved schedule in traffic infraction cases involving regulation of vehicles and traffic for which the penalty specified in section 42-4-1701, C.R.S., or elsewhere in Articles 2 to 4 of Title 42, C.R.S., is less than three hundred dollars.

In agreement with the District Attorney's Office, the 20th Judicial District agrees that civil and traffic infractions shall be processed as follows:

- 1. Any person receiving a summons for a civil infraction shall appear at the Clerk's Office for the Combined Court of the 20th Judicial District and shall be offered a fine reduction of 50% of the fine authorized by statute.
- 2. Any person receiving a summons for a traffic infraction shall appear at the Clerk's Office for the Combined Courts of the 20th Judicial District and shall be offered a fine reduction and point reduction, not including one-point or zero-point offenses. A person with a one-point or zero-point offense will have the opportunity to plead to the original charge and pay fines and costs, including court costs, or set the matter for a final infraction hearing.
- 3. Any defendant receiving a summons shall appear at the Clerk's Office and who wishes to contest the action shall have the matter set for a final infraction hearing in the appropriate intake division.
- 4. Please see Attachment A for a list of traffic and civil infractions subject to reduction. Please see Attachment B for the relevant plea offer letters.

- 5. The 20^{th} Judicial District specifically agrees to point and fine reductions for the following offences:
 - a. 42-2-101(2) Driving with No Operators License First offense (3 points)
 - i. Can be dismissed with proof of valid driver's license or plead guilty to the charge and \$50 fine plus court costs.
 - b. 42-2-138(1.5) Driving Under Restraint: Outstanding Judgement Warrant (3 points)
 - i. Can be dismissed with proof of valid driver's license or plead guilty to the charge and \$50 fine plus court costs.
 - **c. 42-2-138(1)(a) Driving Under Restraint (0 points)**
 - i. Can be dismissed with proof of valid driver's license or plead down to no license on person charge of zero points and \$50 fine plus court costs.

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ADVISEMENT OF RIGHTS

You have been accused of violating the traffic laws of the State of Colorado. A procedure is available for the payment of fines, costs, and surcharges if you voluntarily admit your guilt or liability after being advised of the following rights:

YOU HAVE THE RIGHT TO:

- 1. Be represented by an attorney at your own cost.
- 2. Remain silent because any statement you make may be used against you.
- 3. Deny the allegations against you and have a hearing, at which time the allegations must be proven beyond a reasonable doubt.
- 4. Testify, subpoena witnesses, present evidence, and cross-examine the witnesses for the State.
- 5. Appeal any judgment against you.

Any answer you make must be voluntary and not the result of any undue influence, and you must understand that points may be assessed against your driving record if you admit guilt or liability.

PLEASE NOTE CAREFULLY

Your failure to sign the reverse side of this form and pay the fine and costs or appear on the appearance date indicated on your ticket, will result in a default judgment being entered against you.

If you choose not to accept this plea bargain by mail you must personally appear for your initial court date indicated on your ticket. That appearance is one where you can still accept the same plea bargain or set the case for a Final Hearing. You will not be able to see the County Court Judge, the law enforcement officer, or the District Attorney on that date. Your ticket is considered a civil matter and not a criminal matter. Therefore, the District Attorney's office is not involved in your case and will not negotiate a better plea bargain with you. This will be the only plea bargain that you will be offered with no further reduction in points.

If you wish to dispute your ticket, you may set your case for a Final Hearing which will be held approximately 6-8 weeks from your initial court date. A final hearing is a trial where the law enforcement officer will appear to present his or her case. You will then be given an opportunity to present your case to a County Court Judge.
