## ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 2016-06

## CONCERNING CHANGE OF VENUE OF SHORT TERM MENTAL HEALTH CERTIFICATION CASES

Whereas, pursuant to C.R.S 27-65-106, initial requests for Court ordered evaluations for persons alleged to be mentally ill are filed in the County where the person resides; and

Whereas, a person who is held under C.R.S. 27-65-105 or 106 are sometimes referred for short term commitment under C.R.S, 27-65-107, and

Whereas, persons subject to a certification for short-term treatment under C.R.S. 27-65-107 have certain rights including the right to be represented by an attorney and the right to request a court hearing to review the certification for short-term treatment, the treatment itself or on a request that the treatment be on an outpatient basis; and

Whereas, there are presently no facilities in Montezuma or Dolores Counties capable of holding persons on a short term mental health certification; and

Whereas, C.R.S. 27-65-111 (4) provides that for a change in jurisdiction for the convenience of the parties and the ends of justice, and

Whereas, persons subject to a short term certification and the other parties to the case are almost never located in Montezuma or Dolores Counties.

Now therefore, the undersigned Chief Judge hereby orders that when a notice of short term certification pursuant to C.R.S. 27-65-107 is filed in this court and it appears that the person who is held under that statute is not then located in Montezuma or Dolores Counties, the clerk shall automatically and immediately issue the attached order and change venue to the District Court where the person held is located.
