



## TAKE A TOUR

The Colorado Judicial Branch has two convenient options for those wishing to learn more about the Ralph L. Carr Colorado Judicial Center, the Colorado Judicial Learning Center, and the inner working of the Colorado Judiciary. Guided tours are led by knowledgeable Colorado Supreme Court librarians and volunteer Learning Center staff. Best of all, all tours are **free of charge**.

### a) Scheduled Group Tours

The Colorado Judicial Learning Center is pleased to offer scheduled tours for non-commercial groups of 10 people or more. Depending on your interests, scheduled tours may include a tour of the Ralph L. Carr Colorado Judicial Center (including a discussion of the public art and building architecture), a tour of the Colorado Supreme Court Library, a visit to a courtroom, and an introduction to the Colorado Judicial Learning Center. Scheduled tours usually last approximately 1 hour and devote equal time to the building and the Learning Center. However, tours may be tailored to meet your specific time constraints, interests, and needs.

A member of the Learning Center staff will then contact you to discuss available dates and times, special rules for school visits, and address any questions or special requests you may have. Groups of children under the age of 18 must have at least one chaperon for every 7 children. Larger groups (including multi-class school trips) are encouraged to contact Learning Center staff well in advance of their preferred tour date to discuss visit options.

### b) Self-guided Tours

Visitors are welcome to tour the Ralph L. Carr Colorado Judicial Center, the Colorado Judicial Learning Center, and the Colorado Supreme Court Library during all open building hours.
