Chief Judge Dennis Maes retiring from 10th Judicial District *Commission sets date to select nominees*

The Tenth Judicial District Nominating Commission will meet April 3, 2012, at the Pueblo County Courthouse (320 W. 10th St., Pueblo, CO 81003) to interview and select nominees for appointment by the governor to the office of district judge for the Tenth Judicial District (Pueblo County). The vacancy will be created by the retirement of the Honorable Dennis Maes. The vacancy will occur on June 1, 2012.

To be eligible for appointment to fill the vacancy, the applicant must be a qualified elector of the Tenth Judicial District and must have been admitted to the practice of law in Colorado for five years. The current annual salary for this position is \$128,598. The initial term of office of a district judge is a provisional term of two years; thereafter, the incumbent district judge, if approved by the voters, has a term of six years.

The original and seven copies of the application must be filed with the ex officio chair no later than 4 p.m., Tuesday, March 13, 2012. Late applications will not be considered. Any person wishing to suggest a candidate to fill the vacancy may do so by letter to be submitted to any member of the nominating commission, with a copy to the ex officio chair, no later than 4 p.m., Monday, March 5, 2012.

Instructions

1. The application form for a Colorado state court judgeship can be found on the Judicial Branch website at <http://www.courts.state.co.us/Careers/Judge.cfm>. You should only use the application that says it was updated 04/09. Do not use a prior version of the application. Please be complete and thorough in answering the questions; and, if an answer to any question requires more space than provided, attach a separate sheet of paper for each question.
2. Answers should be typed or printed in black ink and it is preferable that you use plain white paper. Do not use a font smaller than 12 pt. or margins smaller than 1”.
3. Each completed original and all copies of the application may be stapled once in the upper left-hand corner or a large clip or rubber band may be used. Please do not use any sort of binder (no notebooks, covers or tabs).
4. You may request that letters of reference be submitted from up to **five** individuals who are in a position to comment upon your qualifications for a judicial position. You may include the letters with your application, or have them sent separately. However, if sent separately, it is still your responsibility to ensure that all letters of reference (with sufficient copies) are submitted to the Ex Officio Chair by the filing deadline. Letters received late may not receive consideration by the Commission.
5. Your application should be filed with the original and seven copies at the following address:
