## **17<sup>th</sup> Judicial District announces three District Court vacancies** *Commission sets date to select nominees*

The Seventeenth Judicial District Nominating Commission will meet May 15, 2019, at the Adams County Justice Center (1100 Judicial Center Drive, Brighton, CO 80601) to interview and select nominees for appointment by the governor to the office of district judge for the Seventeenth Judicial District (Adams and Broomfield counties). The vacancies will be created by the retirements of the Hon. F. Michael Goodbee, effective July 1, 2019; the Hon. Patrick T. Murphy, effective, July 15, 2019; and the appointment of the Hon. Jaclyn Brown to the Colorado Court of Appeals, effective May 31, 2019.

To be eligible, the applicant must be a qualified elector of the Seventeenth Judicial District at the time of investiture and must have been admitted to the practice of law in Colorado for five years. The current annual salary for this position is \$168,202. The initial term of office of a district judge is a provisional term of two years; thereafter, the incumbent district judge, if approved by the voters, has a term of six years.

The completed application must be e-mailed to the address listed in the instructions below no later than 4 p.m. on April 22, 2019. Late applications will not be considered. Any person wishing to suggest a candidate to fill the vacancy may do so by letter to be submitted to any member of the nominating commission, with a copy to the ex officio chair, no later than 4 p.m. on April 15, 2019. Instructions

1. The application form for a Colorado state court judgeship can be found on the Judicial Branch website at <http://www.courts.state.co.us/Careers/Judge.cfm>. Please be complete and thorough in answering the questions; and, if an answer to any question requires more space than provided, attach a separate sheet of paper for each question. Do not change the margins or font size on the application.

3. Your application materials should be prepared in the following manner:

The application should be saved as a PDF file (preferably in text searchable format. The electronic application does not need to contain a signature. If your application materials include multiple documents (i.e., cover letter, personal statement, reference letters) these documents should be combined into one single PDF document with the reference letters attached last.

You may submit **letters of reference from up to three** individuals who are in a position to comment upon your qualifications for a judicial position. It is preferred that reference letters are included with your application submission. If they are submitted directly by the author, they should be submitted as described below in paragraph 4. It is your responsibility to ensure that all letters of reference are submitted by the filing deadline.

4. Your application materials compiled as outlined above should be sent via email with **your name and 17<sup>th</sup> Judicial District in the subject line** attaching your materials as compiled above no later than **4 p.m. on April 22, 2019**, to the following email address:
