COUNTY JUDGES SITTING AS JUVENILE COMMISSIONERS

County judges may be appointed as juvenile commissioners in judicial districts where there are no juvenile commissioners and where it would be extremely difficult to have a district judge available to set juvenile bonds every day of the week in each county in the district. Pursuant to this authority, chief judges shall make arrangements for a district judge, a juvenile commissioner or a county judge sitting as a juvenile commissioner to be available for bonding purposes at all times as provided by law.
