The advisement for Austin Sigg is set for 8:00 a.m. Thursday Oct. 25, 2012, in Courtroom 4-C of the Jefferson County Courthouse (100 Jefferson Parkway, Golden, CO 80401). It is not a video advisement. Judge Ann Gail Meinster will preside. The Jefferson County Courthouse opens at 7:30 a.m.

**DECORUM ORDER:**

It is expected that a formal decorum order will be entered by the Court on Thursday, Oct. 25, 2012. Meantime, I offer the following logistical information.

**COURTROOM SEATING:**

Courtroom 4-C has limited seating. At this point, the following media organizations have one seat in the courtroom for Thursday's advisement. If your organization is listed below, please find me on the fourth floor of the courthouse prior to the beginning of the hearing to claim your badge. You will need a valid media credential to claim your badge. If other seats become available prior to the hearing they will be distributed on a first-come, first-serve basis. There will be no media overflow room.

**CAMERAS:**

Requests for Expanded Media Coverage were received by the Court and have been denied. There will be no cameras in the courtroom. A written order will follow. Cameras will be permitted in the courthouse. A camera area has been designated on the fourth floor immediately across from the elevators. A camera staging area has also been designated near the entrance to the courthouse. These designated areas will be clearly marked.

**ELECTRONIC DEVICES:**

No electronic devices of any kind will be allowed in the courtroom.

**SATELLITE TRUCK PARKING:**

Parking at the Jefferson County Courthouse will be limited, but space has been reserved for satellite trucks and microwave vans on a first-come, first-served basis. Please position your vehicles at the far end (furthest from the courthouse) of the parking lots on either side of the main driveway leading to the courthouse. It is expected that personnel from Jefferson County will be onsite beginning at 5:00 a.m. to assist with parking positions.
