The Colorado Supreme Court and Court of Appeals has a schedule in place regarding the regular announcement of hearings and opinions. The following is provided as a guide in referencing this information.

## **Supreme Court**

For information, click on "Supreme Court". There you will find:

On Friday mornings, the opinions which will be posted on the following Monday will be announced at "2002 Case Announcements." The Friday list includes only the case numbers and case captions, and does not announce the result of the opinion. The finalized opinions are posted on Monday mornings. The issues addressed at oral argument can be accessed directly through this site. To see the entire opinion, scroll down to case announcements and double click on case announcements for the appropriate Monday (in HTM format), then double click on the case number in the upper right-hand corner of the case. The schedule for oral arguments is also available on this same site.

## **Court of Appeals**

There you will find published "Slip opinions" which are the opinions as filed by the judges with the clerk in the "2002 Case Announcements" section which are posted on Thursday mornings.

Slip opinions are subject to modification, rehearing, withdrawal, or clerical corrections. A link to any modifications to previously posted opinions will appear in the petition for rehearing section of the announcement document the day the changes are announced. Double-clicking on the blue case number will allow you to access the full published opinion. Non-published opinions are marked as such followed by the case's identification information and the outcome of the case such as "JUDGMENT AFFIRMED," "ORDER AFFIRMED IN PART, REVERSED IN PART, AND CASE REMANDED WITH DIRECTIONS," "JUDGMENT AND SENTENCE AFFIRMED IN PART, VACATED IN PART, AND CASE REMANDED WITH DIRECTIONS," "JUDGMENT VACATED, ORDERS REVERSED, AND CASE REMANDED, etc.
