Court of Appeals judge finalists selected *Governor to appoint new Court of Appeals judge*

The Supreme Court Nominating Commission has nominated three candidates for a vacancy on the Colorado Court of Appeals. The vacancy was created by the retirement of the Hon. Dennis A. Graham, effective Feb. 12, 2018. The nominees were selected during meetings on Nov. 28 and 29, 2017, in Denver. They are Michael Beaver of Denver, the Hon. Ted Tow III of Northglenn and the Hon. Jami Vigil of Colorado Springs.

Under the Colorado Constitution, the governor has 15 days from Nov. 30, 2017, within which to appoint one of the nominees as a judge on the Colorado Court of Appeals.
