## First Judicial District Court judge finalists selected Governor to appoint new district court judge

The First Judicial District Nominating Commission has nominated three candidates for a district court judgeship created by the retirement of the Hon. Ann Meinster, effective June 1, 2024. Nominees Paula Anne Holt of Denver, Adam D. Kendall of Wheat Ridge, and Andrew Carl Poland of Lakewood were selected by the commission on April 2, 2024.

Under the Colorado Constitution, the governor has 15 days from April 3, 2024, within which to appoint one of the nominees as district court judge for the First Judicial District (Gilpin and Jefferson counties).
