Jefferson County Court judge finalists selected Governor to appoint new county court judge

The First Judicial District Nominating Commission has nominated three candidates for a

Jefferson County Court judgeship vacated by the non-retention of the Hon. Judy Archuleta,

effective Jan. 13, 2009. Nominees Tammy K. Greene and Marianne Marshall Tims, both of

Littleton, and Thomas A. Walsh of Lakewood, were selected in a Dec. 10 meeting at the

Jefferson County Courts and Administration Building.

Under the Colorado Constitution, the governor has 15 days from Dec. 11, 2008, within

which to appoint one of the nominees as county court judge for Jefferson County.
