Denver Juvenile Court judge finalists selected Governor to appoint new Juvenile Court judge

The Second Judicial District Nominating Commission has nominated three candidates for a Denver Juvenile Court judgeship created by the retirement of the Hon. D. Brett Woods. The vacancy occurred on Feb. 10, 2024. Nominees Lisa M. Gomez, Michal A. Lord-Blegen, and Blair Q. McCarthy, all of Denver, were selected by the commission on March 5, 2024.

Under the Colorado Constitution, the governor has 15 days from March 6, 2024, within which to appoint one of the nominees as district court judge for the Denver Juvenile Court.
