Second Judicial District Court judge finalists selected *Governor to appoint new district court judge*

The Second Judicial District Nominating Commission has nominated three candidates for a district court judgeship created by the resignation of the Hon. Elizabeth A. Starrs. The vacancy will occur on July 1, 2020.

Nominees Jill Dorancy and Adam Espinosa, both of Denver; and David Karpel of Englewood were selected by the commission during a videoconference meeting on April 29, 2020.

Under the Colorado Constitution, the governor has 15 days from April 30, 2020, within which to appoint one of the nominees as district court judge for the Second Judicial District (Denver County).
