El Paso County Court judge finalists selected *Governor to appoint two new county court judges*

The Fourth Judicial District Nominating Commission has nominated five candidates for two El Paso County court judgeships created by the retirements of the Hon. Stephen Sletta and the Hon. Regina Walter, effective Jan. 7, 2019. Nominees Meredith Cord, Samuel Evig, Marcus Henson, Chad Miller and Dulce Peacock, all of Colorado Springs, were selected in a meeting on Aug. 8, 2018, in Colorado Springs.

Under the Colorado Constitution, the governor has 15 days from Aug. 9, 2018, within which to appoint two of the nominees as county court judges for El Paso County.
