El Paso County Court judge finalists selected *Governor to appoint new county court judge*

The Fourth Judicial District Nominating Commission has nominated three candidates for an El Paso County court judgeship created by the retirement of the Hon. Jonathan L. Walker, effective Feb. 15, 2017. Nominees Jessica Curtis and Samuel Evig, both of Colorado Springs, and Shannon Gerhart of Calhan were selected in a meeting on March 14, 2017, at the El Paso County Courthouse.

Under the Colorado Constitution, the governor has 15 days from March 15, 2017, within which to appoint one of the nominees as county court judge for El Paso County.
