Lake County Court judge finalists selected *Governor to appoint new county court judge*

The Fifth Judicial District Nominating Commission has nominated three candidates for a Lake County Court judgeship created by the appointment of the Hon. Jonathan Shamis to the District Court. The vacancy was created on Feb. 9, 2023. Nominees Braden Angel of Avon; and Katherine Duggin and John Scott, both of Leadville, were selected in a meeting on March 10, 2023.

Under the Colorado Constitution, the governor has 15 days from March 10, 2023, within which to appoint one of the nominees as county court judge for Lake County.
