Fifth Judicial District Court judge finalists selected *Governor to appoint new district court judge*

The Fifth Judicial District Nominating Commission has nominated three candidates for a district court judgeship created pursuant to House Bill 13-1035, effective July 1, 2013. Nominees Paul Dunkelman of Silverthorne, Courtney Holm of Edwards and Dewey (Wayne) Patton of Leadville were selected by the commission on May 20, 2013.

Under the Colorado Constitution, the governor has 15 days from May 21, 2013, within which to appoint one of the nominees as district court judge for the Fifth Judicial District (Clear Creek, Eagle, Lake and Summit counties).
