Seventh Judicial District Court judge finalists selected *Governor to appoint new district court judge*

The Seventh Judicial District Nominating Commission has nominated three candidates for a district court judgeship created by the resignation of the Hon. Jeff B. Herron, effective March 1, 2016. Nominees Donald (Cory) Jackson of Ouray, Bennet Morris of Montrose and Keri Yoder of Telluride were selected by the commission on Feb. 2, 2016.

Under the Colorado Constitution, the governor has 15 days from Feb. 3, 2016, within which to appoint one of the nominees as district court judge for the Seventh Judicial District (Delta, Gunnison, Hinsdale, Montrose, Ouray and San Miguel counties).
