Jackson County Court judge finalists selected *Governor to appoint new county court judge*

The Eighth Judicial District Nominating Commission has nominated three candidates for a Jackson County court judgeship created by the retirement of the Hon. Cindy L. Wilson, effective June 5, 2019. Nominees Sherry Cure of Walden, Chelsea Rengel of Denver, and Antonia Sjoberg of Walden were selected in a meeting on Friday, June 28, 2019 at the Larimer County Justice Center.

Under the Colorado Constitution, the governor has 15 days from July 1, 2019, within which to appoint one of the nominees as county court judge for Jackson County.
