Sixteenth Judicial District Court Judge Finalists Selected *Governor to appoint new district court judge*

The Sixteenth Judicial District Nominating Commission has nominated three candidates for a district court judgeship created by the retirement of the Honorable M. Jon Kolomitz, effective Feb. 2, 2013. Nominees William Judson Culver, of Rocky Ford; Rodney D. Fouracre, Sr., of La Junta; and Mark Andrew MacDonnell, of Las Animas, were selected by the commission on Dec. 10, 2012.

Under the Colorado Constitution, the governor has 15 days from Dec. 11, 2012, within which to appoint one of the nominees as district court judge for the Sixteenth Judicial District (Bent, Crowley and Otero counties).
