17th Judicial District Court judge finalists selected *Governor to appoint new district court judge*

The Seventeenth Judicial District Nominating Commission has nominated three candidates for a district court judgeship created by the retirement of the Hon. John E. Popovich, effective May 31, 2017. Nominees Sean Finn, Priscilla Loew and Kyle Seedorf, all of Broomfield, were selected by the commission on April 14, 2017.

Under the Colorado Constitution, the governor has 15 days from April 17, 2017, within which to appoint one of the nominees as district court judge for the Seventeenth Judicial District (Adams and Broomfield counties).
