17th Judicial District Court judge finalists selected *Governor to appoint new district court judge*

The Seventeenth Judicial District Nominating Commission has nominated three candidates for a district court judgeship created by the non-retention of the Hon. Jill-Ellyn Straus, effective Jan. 10, 2017. Nominees Gregory Beacom of Westminster; and Tomee Crespín and Roberto Ramirez, both of Thornton, were selected by the commission on Dec. 12, 2016.

Under the Colorado Constitution, the governor has 15 days from Dec. 13, 2016, within which to appoint one of the nominees as district court judge for the Seventeenth Judicial District (Adams and Broomfield counties).
