17th Judicial District Court judge finalists selected *Governor to appoint new district court judge*

The Seventeenth Judicial District Nominating Commission has nominated three candidates for a district court judgeship created by the retirement of the Hon. Edward C. Moss. The vacancy will occur on Aug. 15, 2020. Amanda DeWick and Emily Lieberman, both of Broomfield; and Bryon Large of Aurora were selected by the commission during a videoconference meeting on July 7 and 8.

Under the Colorado Constitution, the governor has 15 days from July 9, 2020, within which to appoint one of the nominees as district court judge for the Seventeenth Judicial District (Adams and Broomfield counties).
