Adams County Court judge finalists selected *Governor to appoint new county court judge*

The Seventeenth Judicial District Nominating Commission has nominated three candidates for an Adams County Court judgeship created by the retirement of the Hon. Dianna R. Roybal. The vacancy will occur on July 2, 2020. Nominees Brett Martin and MaryAnn “Mariana” Vielma, both of Commerce City; and Madoche Jean of Westminster were selected in a videoconference meeting on July 1, 2020.

Under the Colorado Constitution, the governor has 15 days from July 2, 2020, within which to appoint one of the nominees as county court judge for Adams County.
