18th Judicial District Court judge finalists selected *Governor to appoint new district court judge*

The Eighteenth Judicial District Nominating Commission has nominated three candidates for a District Court judgeship created by the retirement of the Hon. John L. Wheeler. The vacancy will occur Jan. 12, 2021. Nominees Marques Ivey and Don Toussaint, both of Aurora; and Victoria Klingensmith of Parker were selected by the commission on Aug. 24, 2020.

Under the Colorado Constitution, the governor has 15 days from Aug. 25, 2020, within which to appoint one of the nominees as district court judge for the Eighteenth Judicial District (Arapahoe, Douglas, Elbert and Lincoln counties).
