19th Judicial District Court judge finalists selected Governor to appoint new district court judge

The Nineteenth Judicial District Nominating Commission has nominated three candidates for a district court judgeship created by the resignation of the Hon. Ryan Kamada, effective Aug. 20, 2019. Nominees Jerry Manzer, Jr. of Greeley, and Meghan Saleebey and Stephanie Stout, both of Windsor, were selected by the commission on Sept. 11, 2019, during a meeting at the Weld County Courthouse.

Under the Colorado Constitution, the governor has 15 days from Sept. 12, 2019, within which to appoint one of the nominees as district court judge for the Nineteenth Judicial District (Weld County).
