19th Judicial District Court judge finalists selected *Governor to appoint new district court judge*

The Nineteenth Judicial District Nominating Commission has nominated three candidates for a district court judgeship created pursuant to Senate Bill 19-043, effective July 1, 2019.

Nominees Jerry Manzer Jr. and Vincente Vigil, both of Greeley; and Meghan Saleebey of Aurora were selected by the commission on June 19, 2019.

Under the Colorado Constitution, the governor has 15 days from June 20, 2019, within which to appoint one of the nominees as district court judge for the Nineteenth Judicial District (Weld County).
