21st Judicial District Court judge finalists selected *Governor to appoint new district court judge*

The Twenty-first Judicial District Nominating Commission has nominated three candidates for a district court judgeship created pursuant to Senate Bill 19-043, effective July 1, 2019. Nominees Matthew Barrett of Grand Junction, Craig Henderson of Fruita, and Monica McElyea of Breckenridge were selected by the commission on June 14, 2019.

Under the Colorado Constitution, the governor has 15 days from June 17, 2019, within which to appoint one of the nominees as district court judge for the Twenty-first Judicial District (Mesa County).
