Colorado Supreme Court justice finalists selected *Governor to appoint new Colorado Supreme Court justice*

The Supreme Court Nominating Commission has nominated three candidates for a vacancy on the Colorado Supreme Court. The vacancy was created by the resignation of the Hon. Allison H. Eid, effective Nov. 3, 2017. The nominees were selected during a meeting on Nov. 27-28 at the Ralph L. Carr Colorado Judicial Center in Denver. They are Marcy Glenn of Denver, Melissa Hart of Denver and the Hon. Pattie P. Swift of Alamosa.

Under the Colorado Constitution, the governor has 15 days from Nov. 29, 2017, within which to appoint one of the nominees as a justice on the Colorado Supreme Court.
