Colorado Supreme Court justice finalists selected

Governor to appoint new Colorado Supreme Court justice

The Supreme Court Nominating Commission has nominated three candidates for a vacancy on the Colorado Supreme Court. The vacancy was created by the retirement of the Hon. Nathan B. Coats, effective Jan. 22, 2021. The nominees were selected following video interviews on Nov. 5 and 6, 2020. They are Maria Berkenkotter, Timothy Macdonald and Andrea Wang.

Under the Colorado Constitution, the governor has 15 days from Nov. 6, 2020, within which to appoint one of the nominees as a justice on the Colorado Supreme Court.
