
THIS MATTER came before this Court on M. Michael Cooke's and the Colorado Department of Revenue's motion for entry of an emergency stay of the preliminary injunction order entered on December 14, 2006. This Court being advised in the premises of the request enters the following order.

**ORDER**

The emergency stay pending appeal is GRANTED, in part. The preliminary injunction entered on December 14, 2006 is hereby stayed until the close of business, Tuesday, December 19, 2006, so that Defendants may provide guidance to DMV field offices to process and complete applications for identification cards and drivers' licenses in accordance with Colorado statutory standards.
