**ORDER RE: THE CITY OF AURORA'S MOTION FOR CLARIFICATION  
REGARDING THE COURT'S ORDER DATED AUGUST 21, 2014**

This matter came before the Court on a Motion for Clarification filed by the City of Aurora (the "City") in which it asks the Court to make certain additional redactions to the AARP (the "Motion").<sup>1</sup> Having considered the Motion, the Petition, the underlying request for information, the file and applicable authority, the Court grants the Motion in part. The Court has made certain, but not all, of the additional redactions requested by the City.

A copy of the redacted AARR is attached, under seal, to this Order.<sup>2</sup> For the reasons stated in its Order dated August 21, 2014, which is incorporated herein by reference, the Court finds and concludes that disclosure of the redacted version of the AARR to Ms. Clark, and to the public at large, would not result in substantial injury to the public interest and the Court orders that the City may release the redacted version of the AARR to both Ms. Clark and to other members of the public who wish to see it.<sup>3</sup> Once the trial in the Criminal Case is completed, the City may release an un-redacted version of the AARR.

The Court recognizes that the Petition and the Motion raise controversial questions that do not have clear answers. The Court also recognizes that the City may wish to appeal the Court's decision and that any appeal would be rendered meaningless if the redacted version of the AARR was released pending the appeal. Accordingly, the Court hereby stays this Order to

<sup>1</sup> The City submitted two Motions: the Original Motion dated September 10, 2014 and an Amended Motion dated September 18, 2014. Each of the Motions request additional redactions. Some of the additional redactions apparently were requested by the District Attorney's Office and other additional redactions apparently were requested by the Aurora Police Department.


<sup>2</sup> The Court is maintaining in its file a clean version of the AARR, without redactions, as well as copies of the additional redactions requested by the City, for purposes of appellate review.

<sup>3</sup> The City advised the Court at the hearing that it had received at least one additional request under CORA for release of the AARR.

and including October 7, 2014 in order to give the City an opportunity to appeal this Order if it wishes to do so.<sup>4</sup>
