El Paso County Court Judge Finalists Selected *Governor to appoint county court judge*

The Fourth Judicial District Nominating Commission announced it selected and certified to the governor three nominees for a vacancy on the El Paso County Court bench created by the retirement of the Honorable Sylvia A. Manzanares.

The nominees selected during a May 7, 2007, meeting in Colorado Springs are Douglas Joseph Miles of Manitou Springs and Dulce Denise Peacock and Jonathan L. Walker, both of Colorado Springs. The vacancy is effective May 31, 2007.

The Colorado Constitution allows the governor 15 days from the date nominees are submitted to make an appointment.
