First Judicial District offers legal clinic on petitions to seal records

GOLDEN, Colo. – People representing themselves in cases related to sealing criminal records in the First Judicial District (Gilpin and Jefferson counties) will have the opportunity to learn more about the process at an hour-and-a-half long legal clinic.

The clinic, sponsored by the 1st Judicial District and local attorneys, will be held from 2 p.m. – 3:30 p.m. quarterly beginning Thursday, January 23, 2013, in the Jury Assembly Room, 100 Jefferson County Parkway, in Golden. There is no charge to attend this clinic. The remaining 2014 clinics will be held April 24, July 24, and October 23.

The clinic is part of an effort to help the public better understand and prepare their forms to ask the court to seal criminal records. “Citizens come to the court not knowing whether they can seal their criminal record or how to complete the paperwork. This clinic will shed light on the process,” said Judge Randall Arp.
