## **South Korean court-reform delegation visiting 8<sup>th</sup> Judicial District**

FORT COLLINS, Colo. – A group of nine judges and court staff from the Republic of Korea will visit the 8<sup>th</sup> Judicial District on Monday, Jan. 10, 2011, as part of their country's court-reform efforts.

The delegation will meet with Chief Judge Stephen Schapanski and other judges, and with District Administrator Janelle Brunin, Clerk of Court Sherlyn Sampson and Jury Commissioner Lori Johnson. The group also will observe court proceedings including jury selection.

The group is one of 18 visiting the United States in the learning program set up by the Supreme Court of the Republic of Korea. It is facilitated by the International Programs Division of the National Center for State Courts.

Objectives specified by the Korean judges and court staff include observing civil and criminal trials to learn more about trial scheduling, jury selection, bail and bond issues in criminal court, selection of law clerks, and the use and effectiveness of oral arguments.
