Public access terminal installed at Logan County Courthouse *District and County Court civil case information now available*

STERLING, Colo. – The 13th Judicial District has installed a public access terminal at the Logan County Courthouse in Sterling to provide online access to District and County Court civil case filings.

“We are pleased to provide this online resource for the public in two of our district’s courthouses,” said 13th Judicial District Chief Judge Michael K. Singer. “The computer terminals enable users to review cases and access forms while bypassing the clerk’s window. At the same time, staff is always available at the courthouse for one-on-one assistance if necessary.”

Chief Judge Singer also noted that attorneys will benefit by using the terminals when they are at the courthouse without Internet access and need to review case information.

This is the second public access terminal to become available in the 13th Judicial District. The first terminal was installed at the Morgan County Courthouse in Fort Morgan in December of 2011. Other public access terminals may be brought online in the future as resources become available and technology infrastructures permit.

There is no fee for using the public access terminals to review cases. Printouts of case filings are available for \$0.75 per page and court forms may be printed for \$0.25 per page.

The 13th Judicial District is comprised of Kit Carson, Logan, Morgan, Phillips, Sedgwick, Washington and Yuma counties.
