Gilpin County Court Judge Frederic B. Rodgers receives the Anthony Greco Award from the Colorado County Judges Association

The Colorado County Judges Association recently recognized Gilpin County Court Judge Frederic B. Rodgers with the Anthony Greco Award “For Exemplary Achievement and Leadership as a County Court Judge.” The award was presented to Judge Rodgers at this year’s Colorado Judicial Conference.

“I would say almost every county court judge in the state has benefited from Judge Rodgers’ devotion to the law and justice,” said the Hon. Ed Casias, Summit County Court judge and president of the Colorado County Judges Association. “He is always willing to provide insight and legal guidance on the most difficult of issues. The State of Colorado cannot ask for a better example for a county court judge than Fred Rodgers.”

The Anthony Greco Award was named after the late Judge Anthony Greco, who was appointed to the Denver County Court bench by Mayor William McNichols and served from 1970 to 1984. The award was named for Judge Greco to recognize county judges who exemplify the traits to which county judges should aspire and to give all county judges inspiration.

“I am pleased, honored and overwhelmed by this recognition,” Judge Rodgers said. “I have always considered it my privilege to serve the people of Colorado from the bench and to have the relationships that I do with my colleagues in county courts across the state. I never expected to receive an award for simply doing what I consider to be my job.”

Judge Rodgers has been on the Gilpin County Court bench in the First Judicial District since 1986, when he was appointed by Gov. Richard Lamm. Judge Rodgers is the current Chair of the National Judicial College Board of Trustees and has served as president of the Colorado Municipal Judges Association, the Colorado County Judges Association, the National Conference of Special Court Judges, as Chair of the American Bar Association Judicial Division and Vice-president of the Colorado Trial Judges Council.
