## **David Kribs named financial services director for Judicial Branch**

DENVER – The Colorado Judicial Branch announced today that David Kribs, who has served as the branch’s budget and strategic management officer since 1999, has been named director of the Financial Services Division.

“David is an exemplary public servant,” said Colorado Supreme Court Chief Justice Mary Mullarkey. “We expect that he will achieve the same excellence as financial services director that he has demonstrated throughout his career.”

State Court Administrator Gerald Marroney added: “We are very pleased to have David take on this role. David’s thorough understanding of our budget and our financial services operations make him a perfect fit for this directorship.”

Kribs will oversee a division of the State Court Administrator’s Office that manages the Colorado state court system’s finances, including accounting, audit, budget, collections, payroll and purchasing. He replaces Mary Flanigan, who is retiring after having served as budget director in the 1990s and as financial services director since 2000.

“I would also like to thank Mary for her leadership and dedication over the years,” Marroney said. “She will be missed, but we wish her well.”

Kribs holds an undergraduate degree in economics from Colorado State University and a master’s degree in public administration from the University of Colorado. He has 17 years’ experience in budget and financial management including with the budget office of former Denver Mayor Wellington Webb, the state Revenue Department, and the State Court Administrator’s Office.
