DETAILS: U.S. Supreme Court Justice Sonia Sotomayor will join Colorado Supreme Court Chief Justice Michael L. Bender and Colorado Governor John Hickenlooper in a celebration to dedicate the new Ralph L. Carr Colorado Judicial Center. Current and past members of Colorado's Judicial, Executive and Legislative branches, as well as current and former congressional and Federal judiciary members, and leaders of Colorado's legal community also will be in attendance.

CAMERAS: One videographer, one still photographer, and one audio feed for radio will be allowed. The Denver Media Group will decide who will be assigned as the pool and will send those contact names to robert.mccallum@judicial.state.co.us no later than Friday, April 19, 2013.

CREDENTIALS: In addition to the two camera and single audio pool operators, a total of 20 media seats have been made available. The 20 seats will be assigned first-come, first-served in response to this media announcement. No more than one credential per media outlet. Media credentials for the 20 media members must be picked up at the Office of the State Court Administrator (1300 Broadway, Suite 1200) between 10 am and noon on Monday, April 29, 2013.

SECURITY: All visitors to the Ralph L. Carr Colorado Judicial Center are required to clear security screening. Credentialed media must arrive at the courthouse no later than 11:30 a.m. on Thursday, May 2.
