Colorado Judicial Department to launch redesigned Web site *First major update in six years provides users more information, easier navigation*

DENVER – The Colorado Judicial Department announced today that a completely redeveloped Web site designed to provide users with more information and easier navigation will be unveiled Tuesday, Aug. 19.

In the first major update to the department’s Internet presence in six years, the new site will not only include all the self-help documents, information and case announcements available on the previous site, but also will offer enhancements such as online docket information.

“The Internet is often the first place people turn to when looking for any information about the Colorado court system,” said Supreme Court Chief Justice Mary Mullarkey. “We believe the new site will be something all Coloradans can be proud of and give them a reliable, timely source of accurate information.”

The new site will have the same Internet address – www.courts.state.co.us – but links to subpages within the site have changed; users are advised to manually change any current bookmarks or links.

Among the new site’s most significant improvements is a searchable, online docket system that will be updated daily for all courts in the state system. Enhanced home pages for each of Colorado’s 22 judicial districts contain additional data. And the site’s navigation system was carefully crafted to be more intuitive and better organized than the old site.

Colorado was among the first states in the nation to have a Web site for its court system when the original site went online in the mid-1990s. The last major update was launched in September 2002.
