Court canceled at Huerfano County courthouse in Walsenburg due to building damage

WALSENBURG, Colo. – Chief Judge Claude W. Appel of the 3rd Judicial District on Tuesday canceled district and county court proceedings in the Huerfano County courthouse in Walsenburg for the remainder of the week.

Severe weather has caused building damage. The county is now conducting a structural analysis to determine whether it is safe to occupy the building.

Court is expected to resume Monday, April 30, either at the Huerfano County Courthouse or at an alternate location to be announced later this week.
