**Colorado Judicial Branch opens application period for
Judicial Nominating Commission attorney positions**
Five attorneys to be appointed to three commissions by Dec. 31

DENVER – The Colorado Judicial Branch is seeking attorney applicants for vacancies on three judicial nominating commissions. Judicial nominating commissioners are volunteers and serve six-year terms. These attorney appointments are made jointly by the Governor, the Attorney General, and the Chief Justice.

The Supreme Court Nominating Commission will have two attorney vacancies as of Dec. 31. Applicants must be licensed attorneys who reside in the Fourth or Seventh congressional districts. The Supreme Court Nominating Commission selects nominees for judicial vacancies on the Colorado Supreme Court and Colorado Court of Appeals.

The Tenth Judicial District Nominating Commission, which selects nominees for judicial vacancies in that district only, will have two attorney vacancies as of Dec. 31. Applicants must be licensed attorneys who reside in the Tenth Judicial District (Pueblo County).

The Fourteenth Judicial District Nominating Commission, which selects nominees for judicial vacancies in that district only, will have one attorney vacancy as of Dec. 31. Applicants must be licensed attorneys who reside in the Fourteenth Judicial District (Grand, Moffat and Routt counties).
