^{*} Per Section 14-4-107(3)(a)&(b), C.R.S.:

- The money shall be disbursed to each qualifying organization, subject to available appropriations, in proportion to the number of persons living below the poverty line in each county (or city and county) as determined by the most recent census published by the U.S. Census Bureau.
- If there is more than one qualifying organization within a county (or city and county), the proportionate share shall be allocated in proportion to the number of indigent family violence clients served by each qualifying organization or its predecessor in the prior year.
