





NO COST BOND FOR CIVIL APPEALS

ORDER

Colorado Appellate Rule 7, Bond for Costs on Appeal in Civil Cases (2012), requires a bond for costs on appeal in civil cases to be filed by the appellant in the trial court with the notice of appeal. The bond or security in the sum or value of \$250 is collected unless the court determines a different amount. Effective upon signature, the First Judicial District will not ask for a cost bond in any amount as the court no longer incurs any costs when preparing the case on appeal.
