**COVID-19 ORDER REGARDING PRE-TRIAL RELEASE
FROM CUSTODY (SUPPLEMENT TO CJO 2019-10)**

This order is being issued to supplement CJO 2019-10 during the COVID-19 (coronavirus) pandemic.

In CJO 2019-10, the court ordered that:

Pre-trial Officers employed by Jefferson County Justice Services are hereby designated as bonding commissioners pursuant to C.R.S. 16-4-103(1) and are authorized to set bonds in the First Judicial District in certain cases based on criteria approved by the Chief Judge in consultation with the Jefferson County Criminal Justice Coordinating Committee.

Because of the COVID-19 pandemic as described in prior CJOs, the court amends the criteria (attached as Exhibit A) to be used by bonding commissioners to set bonds in certain cases.

To the extent there is a conflict with other Chief Judge Orders, this order governs through May 1, 2020.

RE: Notice of Pre-Advisement Release on Personal Recognizance (PR) Bond During COVID-19 Pandemic

In accordance with C.R.S. 16-4-103, 16-4-104, 16-4-105, and 16-4-106 and pursuant to Jefferson County Chief Judge Order 2020-09, the below-named defendant meets the following criteria for Pre-Advisement Release on a Personal Recognizance (PR) Bond:

- 1. Has been arrested for traffic, misdemeanor, VPO alcohol and/or drug consumption/possession only that does not involve contact with a Protected Party, F4 non-VRA/non-Crime of Violence, F5 or F6 charges
- 2. Arrest charge is not a VRA crime, crime of violence, does not include assault and/or domestic violence, or Escape charge
- 3. Has scored 1, 2 or 3 on the Pretrial Risk Assessment (CPAT)
- 4. Is not on bond for a felony
- 5. Does not have any active warrants for a felony
- 6. Does not have a felony conviction within the past 5 years for a F2 or F3 charge, OR a Crime of Violence or a VRA crime

Mandatory Pretrial Supervision to be added as a bond condition if one or more of the following is the case:

- If arrest charge is alcohol related, Pretrial Supervision with Monitored Sobriety at Pretrial Discretion and No Alcohol will be **mandatory**
- If arrest charge is drug related, Pretrial Supervision with Monitored Sobriety at Pretrial Discretion will be **mandatory**
- Has been arrested for 1st DUI/DUID/DWAI charge (or 2nd that is not within 5 years of 1st). If arrest charge is 2nd DUI/DUID/DWAI, Pretrial Supervision with Monitored Sobriety at Pretrial Discretion will be **mandatory**
- Has a failure to appear in court within the past 5 years on a felony case. If criminal history reflects a failure to appear in court **within the past 5 years for a felony**, Pretrial Supervision will be **mandatory**
