What: This clinic is informational ONLY. It covers the process of divorce, legal separation, dissolution of civil union, and APR (formerly called custody)

- Disclosures
- Status Conferences
- Sworn Financial Statements
- Temporary Orders
- Separation Agreements
- Parenting Plans
- Maintenance/Child Support
- Parenting time and decision-making

FAMILY LAW ASK-AN-ATTORNEY

What: Come learn about collecting on a judgment. An attorney will be teaching you about garnishments, using interrogatories to find assets, exemptions, and transcripts of judgment.

(excluding holidays)

What: Discuss topics including, trusts, estates, wills, powers of attorneys, ADULT guardianships and conservatorships.
