FILING FOR DIVORCE WITHOUT CHILDREN

DO YOU QUALIFY FOR A FAST TRACK DIVORCE?

Every Divorce filed in Colorado has a mandatory minimum waiting period of 91 days from the date of filing before a Divorce Decree can enter; however, many divorces take much longer. *In Jefferson County, there are two ways you may qualify to have your divorce 'fast tracked'* to minimize appearances, paperwork and the time between filing and decree.

SIMPLIFIED DIVORCE (all must apply)
☐ FULL AGREEMENT: NO ISSUES TO RESOLVE.
☐ Total VALUE OF PROPERTY acquired during marriage LESS THAN \$6,000.00
☐ Total DEBT acquired during marriage LESS THAN \$6,000.00
☐ <i>Incomes</i> are <i>comparable</i> ; no maintenance (alimony)
☐ We have read the attached Affidavit to Participate in the Simplified Divorce Process and believe that it is a true and correct reflection of our current situation.
