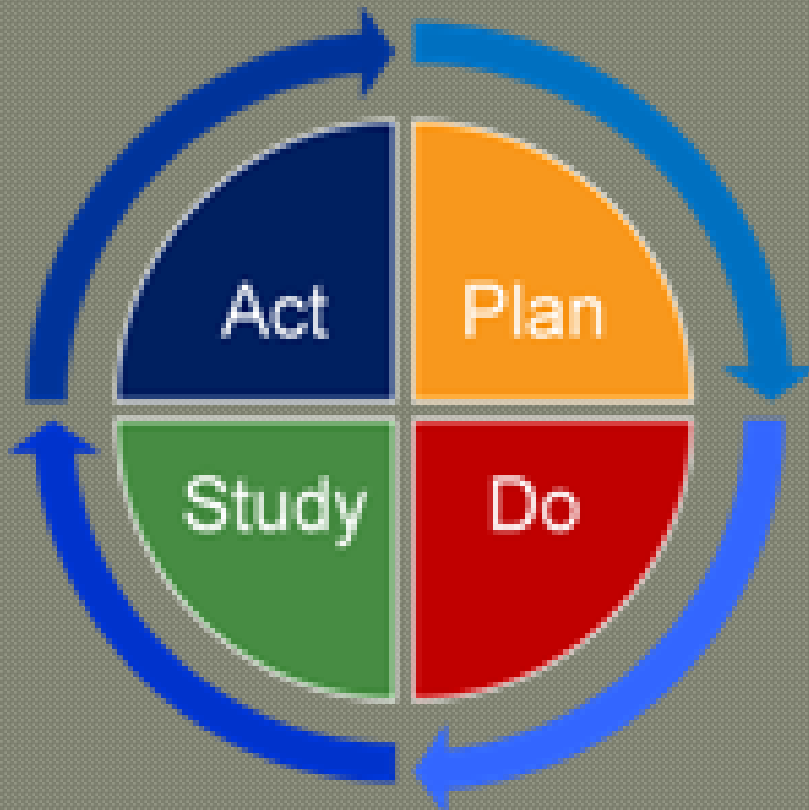

How do we measure our progress toward our CQI goal?

CQI Goal: To Improve the permanency outcomes for children in out-of-home care with a goal of Other Planned Permanent Living Arrangement (OPPLA)

Develop a rating system that meets the following criteria:

- ✓ **Comprehensive**
 - Started with Casey Family Permanency Rating
 - Cover key areas of youth functioning
- ✓ **Understandable**
 - Easily discernable ratings
- ✓ **Timely**
 - Capture initial and regular follow-ups to assess progress
- ✓ **Measureable**
 - Quantitative score, or index, to make it measurable and comparable

What is the tool?

- Composite Permanency Rating Scale
- Consists of 10 questions:
 - Casey Family Perm Ranking
 - Placement Status
 - Education Status
 - Employment Status
 - IL Skills (money mgmt, housing, transportation, health, vital docs)
 - # Permanent Connections
 - Strength of Connections with Bio Parents
 - Strength of Connections with Siblings
 - Strength of Connections with Other Adults
 - Chafee Participation
- Ratings on most range from 1 (Low) to 5 (High)
- Completed when OPPLA goal established and every 90 days thereafter

How does it work?

- Implemented ranking tool in internal “CAT” data system
 - Integrated with Trails data
 - Sends automated emails when youth due for perm rating
- CYF Caseworker completes rating every 3 months
- Tool calculates Individual and overall “Indexes”
 - “Index” represents percentage of maximum possible score in a domain
 - Index scores exclude ‘Not Applicable’ ratings

How will we use and share the results?

- In aggregate - to measure progress on our CQI goal
 - How are we doing overall
 - In what areas are we doing well
 - Where do we need to improve or focus efforts
- Individually - to inform stakeholders of youth-specific permanency and well-being efforts
 - Added as addendum to court reports
 - Shows summary of permanency ratings with progress over time
 - Includes results of each perm rating factor, worker statement on youth's progress, and list of permanent connections
