I. Approval of Minutes

The Committee approved the minutes for the September 17, 2015, meeting.

II. Chair's Update

The Chair updated the Committee on his and the Reporter's progress and discussed publication logistics for the upcoming 2015 edition.

III. Review of Instructions

The Committee reviewed the following instructions:

1. D:08 (Judicial Notice). The Committee continued its discussion of how to modify this instruction in light of *People v. Doyle*, 2015 CO 10, 343 P.3d 961. The Committee elected to have the Reporter send out pertinent materials in order to resolve the issue at the November meeting.
2. G2:01 (Criminal Attempt). The Committee took up a suggestion from an attorney regarding Comment 4. It voted to change the word "deliberately" in that comment to the phrase "after deliberation."
3. Draft of Chapter 7-7 (Sexual Conduct in a Correctional Institution). The Committee debated this chapter in detail. It determined that the Reporter should draft new versions of the chapter's elemental instruction and relevant interrogatories for the Committee's review.
4. Draft of Chapter 8-3 (Bribery and Corrupt Influences). The Committee reviewed several draft instructions in this chapter, finishing with Instruction 8-3:09: Attempt to Influence a Public Servant. It intends to complete review of this chapter at the November meeting.

IV. Next Meeting

The next regular meeting of the Committee will be held on Thursday, November 19, 2015, 3-5 p.m., in supreme court conference room #4244. The Chair will set an agenda and have the Reporter distribute relevant written materials in advance of the meeting.
