Order After Status Conference on 10/22/20		

The Court held a status conference on 10/22/20. The Court will issue an order on the two outstanding defense motions before the next status conference. The next status conference is set for 10/27/20 at 3:00 PM wherein the Court will again, off the record run through procedures for jury selection and the rest of the trial with counsel.

Both sides shall email the Court and each opposing counsel a list of their proposed witnesses by the close of business on Friday, 10/23/20.

The Court ordered that bench conferences initially be discussed between the parties and Court via e-mail that also includes the court reporter so that a proper record is made of the communications.

The Court misstated on the record the time Mr. Redwine will be present in the courthouse each morning of trial. Mr. Redwine will arrive on or before 7:45 AM each day, not 7:30 AM. After the jury is selected, the Court intends to start the trial each day between 8:20 and 8:30 AM. Counsel need to be prepared to start by 8:20 AM each day after the jury is selected. If matters need to be discussed prior to the jury being brought to the courtroom, the parties should be prepared to hold those proceedings at 8:00 AM.


The prosecution shall set up their re-creation of the Redwine living room in Judge Carlson's courtroom on Veteran's Day. The prosecution shall arrange for the defense team to see the re-creation on Veteran's Day so that both sides will be prepared to argue prior to the Court ruling upon the prosecution's motion for a jury view.

The prosecution and defense shall communicate with one another regarding clear face masks being provided for Mr. Redwine at prosecution expense.

After the jury is selected, so long as Webex Events is able to stream the trial on the internet, the actual courtroom shall be closed to the public which will leave 12 seats available after accounting for the jury, alternate jurors and court staff. The Court therefore orders that the defense shall be allowed to have 5 persons in the courtroom at any one time after the jury is selected. This number includes the defendant and may be any five persons defense counsel believes appropriate. The prosecution shall be allowed to have a total of 7 persons in the courtroom at any time after the jury is selected. If Webex Events at some point is unable to stream the proceedings in the courtroom, the Court will take a short recess, limit the number of persons each side may have in the courtroom and open the courtroom to the public.

Defense counsel shall file a written objection to the updated expert endorsement of the prosecution witness discussed at the status conference by 10/23/20. The prosecution shall respond by 10/26/20.
